



THE RIGHT STUFF

We have four different materials to choose from when you're picking a flag. Different materials work best in different conditions, so pick the one that's right for your course.

400-Denier Nylon	For heavier winds, the heavy-duty material in these flags helps them last longer.
200-Denier Nylon	These mid-weight nylon flags are highly visible and blow freely even in lower wind conditions.
Venti-Knit®	The vented fabric in these flags helps minimize the effects of high-velocity winds.
Polyester	This is the strongest, longest-lasting fabric available. The 100% two-ply, spun polyester withstands strong winds and intense sun exposure.

FLAG ORDERING CODES

When ordering, you'll see a large array of product numbers and codes. Here's how to tell what you're looking at.

00000	A 5-digit product number with no letter at the end means the flag uses brass grommets for fastening.	00000TX	Heavy-duty 400-denier nylon flags are indicated with a "TX" at the end of the product number.
00000T	A "T" at the end of the product number signifies a Tube-Lock™ Flag, with the swivel built into the flag.	00000TC	"TC" indicates a ClearCover™ Tube Flag, which protects the Tube-Lock™ swivel from dirt build-up after repeated contact with the green.
