## THE KIRBY MARKERS SYSTEM

### GOOD

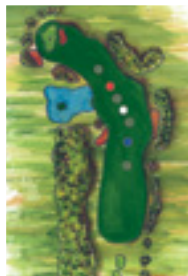
Traditional red, white, blue and yellow—unnumbered down the middle at 50-yard intervals. Because they're above the turf (and can be mowed right over) they're visible from any direction.

No more hunting for below-the-ground disks or painted bricks. No more removing stakes to mow fairways and roughs. An average course takes 42 fairway markers for a single row at 50 yard intervals.



### BETTER

Red, white, blue, yellow down the middle with our original green markers filling in the gaps. Kirby Markers at 25-yard intervals eliminates time consuming pacing. OR both sides of the fairway, red, white, blue, yellow. Not everyone hits it down the middle and this placement gives the golfer a more accurate yardage from the left or right and eliminates guessing on doglegs. A typical course uses 84 markers for a single row at 25 yard intervals or double row at 50 yard intervals.



### BEST

Original green markers, with yellow or white numbers, on both sides of the fairway at 25-yard intervals. The fairway cut provides the perfect reference for markers to be spotted from 15-20 yards. No more hunting for randomly placed sprinkler heads, or pacing from bushes or discs 50 yards apart. Invisible from the tee area, yet right there when you need them. A typical 18 hole system uses approximately 160 fairway markers for a double row at 25 yard intervals.
